From the 1950s to the 70s, chromium contaminated water was flushed from cooling towers and seeped into the regional aquifer at the Los Alamos National Laboratory. We are seeing our extraction treatment and injection methods are reducing the chromium concentrations and the plume footprint is being reduced in size.
